

VETERINARY HEALTH ATTESTATION FOR CHICKEN

Lesotho Permit Number

I,..... the under designed veterinarian/official authorized by the Director of Veterinary Services is South Africa attest to the following;

The chicken meat was derived from birds which were hatched, reared and slaughtered in South Africa;

The birds must have originated from farms not under any veterinary restrictions for any disease to which the species are susceptible;

Originate form an area free of New Castle disease or any contagious diseases;

The birds were slaughtered and processed at an abattoir with approved export slaughter and processing facilities, the chicken meat must have been inspected by an authorized meat inspectors and found for human

All package/wrapping must bear the official inspection stamp of the slaughter plant/processing facility;

The vehicle transporting meat must conform to acceptable standards of cleanliness, construction, maintenance and is equipped with a continuous registering thermograph;

The chicken meat were loaded and sealed by authorized officials and the seal number indicated on the international veterinary certificate;

The exporter/importer has been informed to undertake to inform the government veterinary officials nearest to the point of destination so that he could unseal and check the consignment;
